Ask:

• How can I PROSPER in All Classes?

Imagine:

- Using the SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Timely) Goal acronym, students create a quarter report card goal. What do you IMAGINE earning on your report card?
- Students then select a mosaic tile that represents their goals & color them using either warm or cool colors. Each tile is added to the Engineering Process board to create the "I CAN" artwork.

Plan:

- Each week, Study Skills focuses on adding Study Skills strategies using the acronym PROSPER:
 - o Plan & Prioritize (Time Management)
 - o Respond Responsibly (Decision Making)
 - o Organize (Organizational Strategies)
 - o Set SMART Goals (Goal Setting)
 - o Prepare to Pass (Study Strategies)
 - o Engage in Education (Learning Styles)
 - o Read & Record (Note-taking Strategies)

Create:

• Each week, students earn badges for achieving or mastering PROSPER elements.

Improve:

- Students reflect on their quarter report card SMART goal:
 - o What is working well to achieve that goal?
 - o What can be improved moving forward to achieve that goal?
